July 13, 2015, cont'd.

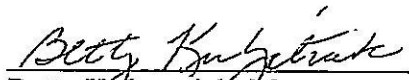
Chief Sutton told Council that Captain Riley caught a thief and uncovered a new meth lab. Mayor Kirkpatrick and Council thanked him for his hard work.

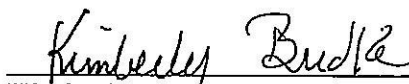

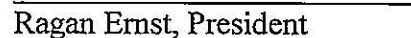
Ms. Budke made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

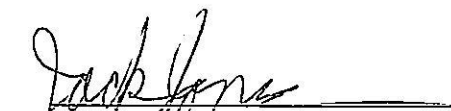
