

ORDINANCE 2001-05**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING COURT COST
AND TERMINATING COMPUTER FUND ASSESSMENT
AND PASSED AS AN EMERGENCY MEASURE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville has a current Court cost of forty-five dollars (\$45.00); and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Hamersville also has a current computer fund which is part of the Court cost being ten dollars (\$10.00) of the Court cost being transferred to the computer fund, and;

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Hamersville deems that the computer fund has sufficient funds in it at the present time and there is no longer a need for an assessment to go to the computer fund, and;

WHEREAS, Council of the Village of Hamersville feels it is necessary to increase the Court cost to generate funds for providing police protection for the safety of the Village.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

Section 1: The Court cost of the Village of Hamersville shall be fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 2: The computer fund assessment shall be terminated with the passage of this ordinance so that all fifty dollars (\$50.00) Court cost goes to the general fund for maintaining the police department of the Village of Hamersville.

Section 3: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of

Hamersville, Ohio, require the immediate issuance of said ordinance and the same shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption.
