RESOLUTION NO: 2004- 05

RESOLUTION FOR ELECTION ON TAX LEVY EXCEEDING TEN-MILL
LIMITATION

The Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, met in regular session on the 12 day
of July, 2004 with the following members present:

Council person Mr. Ogle moved the adoption of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, at least two-thirds of
all the members concurring:

1. The amount of taxes that may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide for the necessary requirements of the Village of Hamersville and it is necessary to levy a tax exceeding that limitation for the current expenses of the subdivision pursuant to Section 5705.19 (a) of the Ohio Revised Code.
2. The proposed levy is a renewal of an existing levy of 1.7 mills outside of the ten-mill limitation, approved by the voters in November, 2004. The renewal levy will constitute a tax of 1.70 mills for each dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.17 for each \$100 of valuation.
3. The levy shall remain in effect for five (5) years for the tax years 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 & 2008
4. The Clerk of the Village of Hamersville shall certify a copy of this resolution to the Board of Elections of Brown County not later than August 19, 2004 and request the Board to provide for notice of the election as required by law.

Council person Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and the roll was called on its adoption, with the following results:
