

VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE
 RECONVENED COUNCIL MEETING.
 JUNE 12, 1995

PRESENT: MAYOR STEVEN BOWYER, COUNCIL MEMBERS Joyce Craig, Martha Hanes, Jesse Nester, Duane Neu, Wyndal Staggs.
 Absent: Sue Sowers Clerk Treasurer Sherri Lewis
 Also Present: Mack Hanes-President Board of Public Affairs

Mayor Bowyer asked for a motion to reconvene the meeting from June 5, 1995. Craig motioned and Hanes seconded the motion to reconvene. Voting: Craig-YEA Hanes-YEA Nester-YEA Neu-YEA Staggs-YEA. Voting Nay-NONE.

Due to the absence of the Clerk Sherri Lewis, Martha Hanes made the notes for the minutes.

Melinda Gross and Pat Adkins entered at this time and requested that Council consider making Wooster Avenue a one way street from Park Avenue to Fite Avenue due to the fact that Wooster Avenue is very narrow and that cars speed on this street. After a short discussion this was referred to the street committee to check on and bring a report back to the next regular council meeting.

Council had requested that the Clerk Treasurer bring all of the Village books and bank statements up to date and present them to council at this time, however the Clerks mother Marlene Lewis had dropped the books off prior to the meeting saying that Sherri was ill and would not be present.

Council and the Mayor checked the books and found in their opinion that the books were in very poor condition and not up to date, including the bank statements not being balanced and the minute books not being complete.

At this time council instructed the Mayor to call the village Solicitor to come to the meeting.

Mayor Bowyer reached the Solicitor at the Bethel Council meeting who said he would be here in fifteen minutes.

Council took a short recess until the Solicitor arrived.

George Leicht entered the meeting at this time.

After much discussion about the unpaid bills of the village including Workers Compensation a motion was made by Neu seconded by Staggs to pay 60% (Sixty) of last years amount to get the village in good standing. Voting: NEU-YEA STAGGS-YEA NESTER-YEA CRAIG-YEA HANES-YEA. VOTING NAY: NONE.

George Leicht will contact the Bureau of Workers Compensation to see if this is acceptable and if so will see that the check is forwarded to them

Until we get a ruling that we are insured we will not be able to work any of the village employees except Kay Elliott.

A discussion was held on the parking situation along Wayne Avenue next to the ball diamond and council is in agreement that the Jr. Sports Assn. should approach the school board and get permission to put in gravel and create some off street parking. If the Sports Association will get this permission in writing

then the village will be willing to help with the project by getting some gravel.

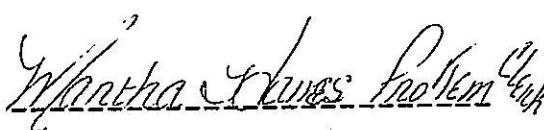
