Board of Public Affairs Meeting
Monday June 19, 1995
7:10.P.M.

Present: Mack Hanes-President BPA, Ed Martin, Martha Hanes, Clerk-Treasurer, Mayor Steven Bowyer, Joyce Craig, Paul Rose, Kay Elliott, Colby Saylor.

Mr. Hanes called the meeting to order at 7:10 P.M.

Martha Hanes the Clerk Treasurer informed the Board that due to the resignation of the Clerk Treasurer Sherri Lewis there was no minutes from the May 1995 meeting and there is no financial report.

Martha Hanes presented a list of bills and informed the board what each bill was for. Mr. Martin motioned , seconded by Mr. Hanes to pay the bills as presented

A survey is to be mailed to see what the feeling is for the sewers.

Colby Saylor reported that he cannot read some of the meters because the dogs are running loose and are not too friendly.

It was suggested that the Board send the dogs owners a certified letter telling them we will not read their meters until the dogs are tied up.

Mr. Martin brought up the tree limbs on the Charles Patterson property on North Ave. and the fact that the limbs are hanging over the roadway.

Lynn Dunn will be instructed to trim the limbs the first time he has free time.

Mr. Saylor reported that he and Mr. Talley had changed eight (8) water meters.

Kay Elliott reported that she had sent seventy nine (79) Shut off notices.

Kay also asked permission to have the other three thousand (3000) post cards printed for the billing of the utilities.

A discussion on the Alan Hays property on Fite Ave. was held and the fact that he has someone living in an old barn and is billing them for water. This will be checked out.

Mr. Hanes reported that Lynn Dunn had installed a new service line to MAP INDUSTRIES on Fite Ave.

Mr. Hanes also reported that the truck from the electric department will have to be rebid in the News Democrat for three weeks.

Mr. Hanes reported that the Roofing Contractor will be here on Thursday.

Mr. Hanes told the Board that The D.A.R.E. Community Project will be on Monday June 26, 1995 and they will be working on Hannah Community Park.

Mr. Hanes said they needed a Port-O-Let and that he had contacted Rumpke and they will furnish one for Fifty Dollars. (50) . Mr. Martin motioned seconded by Mr. Hanes to pay the Fifty Dollars. Voting Martin: YEA: Hanes: YEA. Voting: NAY: NONE. MOTION CARRIED.

Paul Rose Reported that he was going to start work on the Water tower this week if it was not too wet.

The electric rate increase was discussed and this will be checked out more.

Mr. Hanes motioned to adjourn seconded By Mr. Martin. Voted and Carried.
