

ORDINANCE NO. 269

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE VILLAGE FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING FUND AND  
CREATING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Incorporated Village  
of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4ths) or more  
of all members elected thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION 1.

That there is hereby created a Village fund under authority  
of 5705.09 and 5705.12 known as the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund.

SECTION 2.

That all revenue received from the Federal Government under  
the new Federal Revenue Sharing Law shall be deposited by the  
Village of Hamersville, Ohio in a separate bank account and into  
a separate fund known as the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund.

SECTION 3.

That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance in order for  
the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, to accept distributions under  
the Federal Revenue Sharing Law and it is necessary to be passed  
for the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of  
the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, and shall be in immediate effect  
upon its passage.
