Regular Village Council Meeting
April 13, 2009

Mayor Talbott called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then the led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Revenue Status, Appropriation Status and Fund Status reports, and the March, 2009 Bank Reconciliation. There will be Village wide yard sales the first full Thursday-Saturday of each month May through October.

Mr. W. Staggs made a motion to rescind Ordinance 2004-04 regulating yard sales, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
