 Ms. Craig entered the meeting at 8:15 P.M.

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order and apologized
 to the Board of Public Affairs for his misunderstanding of the
 Solicitors statement at the Council meeting.

This special meeting was called by the village council
 to try and correct the rate increase for the Village Electric
 Sesame. The B.P.A. had requested a 10% increase however Council
 only approved a 5% increase.

Mayor Bowyer said the village solicitor is in limbo because
 he is not in possession of the correct rate of increase.

Mr. Staggs apologized to the B.P.A. and asked if Council
 could make a wrong right. Mr. Dean replied that is what we are
 asking for; when we try to pass a resolution don't try to second
 guess us.

A motion was made by Mr. Staggs seconded by Mr. Dean Jr.
 to amend ORDINANCE 1993-05 A to read a 10% increase in Village
 Electric Rates effective with the April 1993 billing. Voting:
 Staggs: YEA, Dean: YEA, Johnston: YEA, Hanselman: YEA, Neu:
 YEA. Voting: NAY: None. MOTION CARRIED.

The condition of the roof on the Building on Mill Street
 was discussed and Mr. Staggs and Mr. Neu reported that they
 had inspected the roof and found it to be in serious need of
 repair. Mr. Dean Sr. said the best and most positive repair
 is to get rid of that flat roof and have someone give you some
 estimates A.S.A.P.

The Committee is going to ask for estimates on repairs
 as follows:

Mr. Hanselman will contact Hanke Builders.

Mr. Staggs will contact Stutz Brothers and The Canter Brothers.
 and will report back at the next council meeting.

Mayor Bowyer asked Council what they wanted to do about
 Office Neel since he is not working his scheduled hours and
 not calling the Chief.

After a long discussion it was suggested to Mayor Bowyer
 and Chief Canter that Officer Neel be removed from the schedule
 and asked to turn in his radio so it can be passed along to
 the officer on the Street.

The Police Committee, Mayor, and the Chief are going to

meet with Officer Neel and see if they can get this situation corrected .

Roger Adkins was present and spoke on the sewers and what he thinks is going on with the group that is against the sewer project.

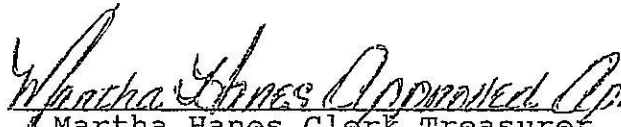
Mayor Bowyer thanked everyone for their attendance and asked if there was any further business to come before the meeting.
