Regular Village Council Meeting
 July 11, 2011

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Ragan Ernst, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Wyndal Staggs and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status Reports, and the June, 2011 Bank Reconciliation.
