

ORDINANCE NO. 1976-7

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT
OF A CLERK OF THE MAYOR'S COURT IN
HAMERSVILLE, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members thereof concurring:

SECTION I. That there shall be employed a person to serve as Clerk of the Mayor's Court of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, to perform services when the Mayor's Court is in session in order to assist the Mayor in the conducting of Mayor's Court.

SECTION II. That the person employed as Clerk of the Mayor's Court shall be paid the sum of \$ 60.00 per mo., payable monthly for services rendered as Clerk of the Mayor's Court.

SECTION III. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the public safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, for the reason that the Mayor's Court docket has grown and in order to render proper service to the members of the public being cited before the Mayor's Court, it is necessary to employ a Clerk of the Mayor's Court and this ordinance shall be in immediate effect upon its passage.
