Regular Village Council Meeting
 June 11, 2012

Present: Mayor Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Ragan Ernst, Pat Scott, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, John Kirby and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Fiscal Officer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the May, 2012 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all members voting yes. All other reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

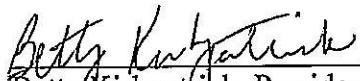
Mayor Staggs will talk to Mr. Mootz about installing some culverts in the Village, as Ronnie Blair is very busy at the moment.

The Mayor and Chief Canter will meet with the Police Officers on the 26th.

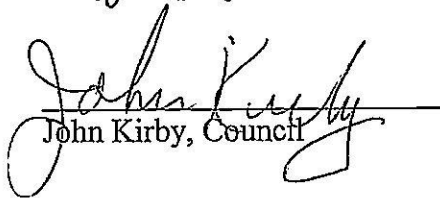

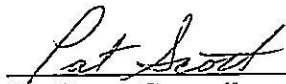
Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Ernst seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

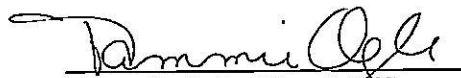
