

ORDINANCE NO. 1995-11

ADOPTING THE 1995 S-17 SUPPLEMENT TO THE
REVISED OHIO BASIC CODE FOR THE VILLAGE
OF HAMERSVILLE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has completed an updating of the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of Hamersville, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of Council to accept such supplements to its codified ordinances, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation of the municipal departments, and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety that this ordinance take effect at an early date: now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the 1995 S-17 Supplement to the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of HAMERSVILLE, as reviewed and approved by Council, is hereby adopted.

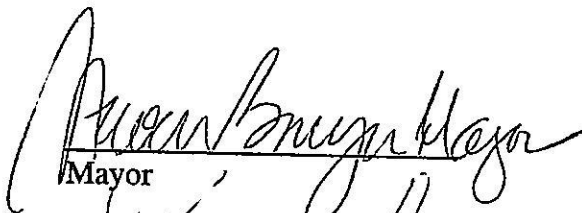
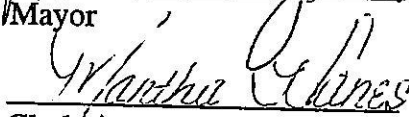
Section 2. One copy of the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of HAMERSVILLE together with the 1995 S-17 Supplement, shall be kept on file in the office of the Clerk of the Village. The Clerk is authorized and directed to publish a summary of all new matters contained in the 1995 S-17 Supplement to the Revised Ohio Basic Code for the Village of HAMERSVILLE as required by R.C. § 731.23.

Section 3. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of HAMERSVILLE so as to conform Village ordinances to recent changes in state law, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that on AUG. 14, 1995 there was enacted by the Council of the Village of HAMERSVILLE an ordinance entitled "ADOPTING THE 1995 S-17 SUPPLEMENT TO THE REVISED OHIO BASIC CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

A summary of the subjects, including all new matters contained in the 1995 S-17 Supplement as adopted, follows:

TITLE I: GENERAL PROVISIONS

- Chapter 10. General Provisions. This chapter contains general provisions and rules of construction that are operative throughout the code.

TITLE III: ADMINISTRATION

- Chapter 35. Fire. Department. This chapter contains provisions from state law setting forth the powers and duties of the fire department.

- Chapter 36. Civil Actions Against the Municipality. This chapter contains provisions from state law which deals with lawsuits against the village government.

TITLE VII: TRAFFIC CODE

- Chapter 70. General Provisions. This chapter contains provisions applicable to the entire chapter.
- Chapter 71. Licensing Provisions. This chapter contains provisions from state law governing the licensing of motor vehicles.
- Chapter 72. Traffic Rules. This chapter contains provisions from state law governing the operation of vehicles.
- Chapter 73. Motor Vehicle Crimes. This chapter contains provisions from state law prohibiting certain conduct to regard to vehicles.
- Chapter 74. Equipment and Loads. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating motor vehicle equipment and loads.
- Chapter 76. Parking Regulations. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating parking.

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- Chapter 76. Parking Regulations. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating parking.

TITLE IX: GENERAL REGULATIONS

- Chapter 92. Intoxicating Liquors. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating the sale and use of alcoholic beverages.
- Chapter 93. Nuisances. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating or prohibiting certain acts declared as nuisances.

TITLE XIII: GENERAL OFFENSES

- Chapter 131. Offenses Against Property. This chapter contains provisions from state law prohibiting certain acts which interfere with the use of property.
- Chapter 135. Offenses Against Persons. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating certain acts which endanger persons.
- Chapter 136. Offenses Against Justice and Administration. This chapter contains provisions from state law prohibiting certain acts which interfere with justice and administration.
- Chapter 138. Drug Offenses. This chapter contains provisions from state law regulating the use, sale, and possession of specified drugs.
- Chapter 139. Miscellaneous. This chapter contains provisions concerning sanitation and health.
