Regular Village Council Meeting
November 12, 2001

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle, and the following members of the Village Council: Donnie Sowers, Larry Talbott, Wyndal Staggs, Ray Fore and Joyce Craig
Also Present: Jesse Nester, Chief Jim CAnter, Dallas Hurt, Betty Kirkpatrick, Scott Lanter, Kenny Green and Jerry Faddis.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Neu then recognized Jesse Nester, a resident of the Village.

Mr. Nester asked the Council where he stands as a citizen of Hamersville. He complained about the noise where he lives, with people "drag racing" on Richey Street. He also asked if it is or is not permitted to burn trash within the Village. Some people burn theirs, whereas he got rid of his bin he used to burn in. The Council informed Mr. Nester that the State has laws that make it illegal to have open fires in town. Mr. Staggs made a motion not to give permission to anyone to burn. Mr. Fore seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Hurt presented the Ordinance from Peck, Shaffer and Williams for sewer financing. Mr. Staggs asked if this will bind us to what Dallas is now doing. Mr. Hurt replied that we can still back out if we change our minds. Mr. Talbott made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an Ordinance three times. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Sowers made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2001-16, providing for the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$1,020,000.00 of Sewer system mortgage bonds. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

There will be someone from Barnes Pumps here to work with Kenny on the sewer system. They will waive their usual fees, and just ask to be reimbursed for their travel and lodging, in the amount of \$350.00. Mr. Talbott motioned to allow this, and Ms. Craig seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Staggs will call tomorrow.

Mayor Neu recognized Jerry Faddis, who came to discuss the game room he just opened in town. The license fee for video games is \$25.00 per year, and \$15.00 per year if paid after July. Since this is November, Mr. Faddis would like the Council to pro-rate the fees. He has ten

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games in town, and he does not want to pay \$150.00 for a month and a half. The Council refused his request, saying that the fee is already pro-rated. Mr. Faddis accused Hamersville of not being very "business friendly". He will come in tomorrow and pay.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to accept the minutes from the previous meeting as presented by the Clerk Treasurer. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

The Board presented their recommendation on hiring Luther Shaffer to replace Lynn Duunn. Mr. Sowers made a motion to hire him as presented, and Mr. Fore seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mayor Neu read Brien Malicote's letter of resignation from the Council, effective 11-12-01. Mr. Staggs made a motion to accept the resignation. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

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Chief Canter wants to send a "Thank You" card to the fire department for their help on Beggar's Night. Two Hours is too long for trick or treat. Chief Canter also made reference to talk that is going on in the Village. He told the Council that if someone had a problem or a complint, they should talk to the person with whom they have that problem. This is a small town, and we all need to work together. Mr. Staggs asked about the fire lane and speeding at the school. Mr. Fore asked if there was anything that the Police Department needed. Chief Canter told him they have what they need for now.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Fore seconded the motion, and the motion carried, with all members voting yes.
