Regular Village Council Meeting
January 13, 2003

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Larry Talbott, Kevin Ogle, Wyndal Staggs, Betty Kirkpatrick, Crystal Haas, Diana Shuemake and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Police Chief Jim Canter, Lonny Riley, Jared Riley, Kenny Green and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Neu called this meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., and then led the assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Neu read the resignation from Phillip Patton, and Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the resignation. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, with all members voting yes. Mr. Patton's Police Department I.D. was then destroyed.

Mr. Talbott made a motion to change regular Council meeting time back to 7:00 p.m. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes, with Ms. Shuemake abstaining from her bill.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented by the Clerk Treasurer. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried,

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with all members voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to increase the Council Member's salaries to \$50.00 per meeting, beginning with the next group elected. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to double the Mayor's monthly salary of \$125.00 to \$250.00, beginning with the next election. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to give all hourly employees a \$.50 per hour raise, retroactive to January 1. Mr. Ogle seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to raise the Clerk Treasurer's salary to \$1,000.00 per month, to be split between the Council and Board, retroactive to January 1. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, with all voting yes, except Mr. Ogle, who abstained.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to raise the Mayor's Court Clerk's salary to \$175.00 per month, retroactive to January 1. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Talbott thanked Mr. Staggs for all of his time and work on the sewers.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to suspend the remainder of Jared Riley's probation, and hire him as a part-time Police Officer at \$8.50 per hour. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Jared would also like to do some of the Street work when it gets warmer. Mr. Ogle made a motion to pay him \$8.50 per hour to do so, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs suggested looking for some property to purchase for a new building with all of the offices together. The other members agreed that it is a good idea.

Ms. Potts will call Ms. Clark's attorney to check on the status of the blue house.

Chief Canter asked for some new high output lights for the Mayor's Court room. They are about \$30.00 each. Mr. Ogle made a motion to

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purchase the lights, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Chief Canter thanked the Council for the new cruiser, radar units and shotgun on behalf of the Police Department. He told Council that they understand that the budget is tight. The new cruiser will be finished by the end of the week.

Ms. Kirkpatrick thanked the Police Department for the plaque they gave her.

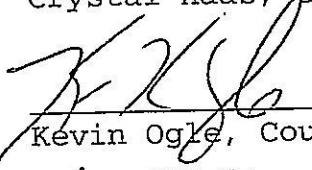
Chief Canter is still working on the theft of the tools.

Ms. Shuemade bought some Christmas decorations for the Village.

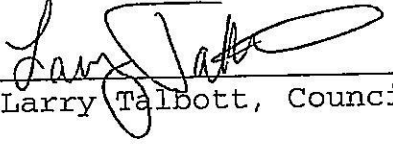
Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Haas seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

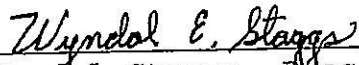

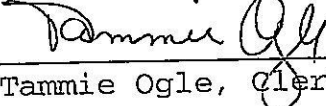
