Special Council Meeting
January 18, 1993 8:30 P.M.

Hamersville, Ohio 45130

Present: Mayor Steven Bowyer, Clerk Treasurer Martha Hanes,
Council Members: Cheryl Craig, William Dean Jr. James Johnston,
Duane Neu, Wyndal Staggs.

Absent: Patrick Hanselman.

Also Present: William Dean Sr. Mack Hanes, Edward Martin. and
Irv Crosswaite, and Chief James Canter and Lonny Riley of the
Hamersville Police Department.

Mayor Bowyer called this special meeting to order and recognized
Mr. Irv Crosswaite from Irv's Auto Sales. Mr. Crosswaite
addressed the council in regard to the no truck parking signs
that have been installed on Main Street between State Route
774 and Bank Street on the South side of State Route 125 and
between North Ave. and State Route 774 on the North side of
125. Mr. Crosswaite stated that these signs hurt his business
because trucks could not stop in front of his shop to unload
parts and supplies. Mr. Crosswaite also stated that many of
his customers drive pick up trucks and they are not allowed
to park while looking at his cars he has for sale.

Mr. Crosswaite said he had not been contacted before the
signs were installed and was not aware that council was going
have the signs installed.

After a long discussion Mayor Bowyer ordered a ten minute
recess so the members of council could look at a possible
solution to the parking on Mr. Crosswaite's roll back truck.

Mayor Bowyer reconvened the meeting and Mr. Crosswaite
and Council members agreed on moving the no parking sign on
route 774 so Mr. Crosswaite could park his roll back truck there.

Mr. Staggs motioned to leave the no parking signs as they
are. There was more discussion and Mr. Staggs withdrew his
motion.

Mayor Bowyer referred the NO TRUCK PARKING ISSUE BACK TO
THE STREET COMMITTEE FOR FURTHER STUDY AND INSTRUCTED THEM TO
REPORT AT THE NEXT COUNCIL MEETING.

Mr. Neu motioned to move the NO TRUCK PARKING sign up 30
feet for 10 days so Mr. Crosswaite can load and unload his cars
this was seconded by Mr. Dean. voting Neu: YEA, Dean: YEA, Craig:
YEA, Staggs: YEA. Voting: Nay: Johnston. **MOTION CARRIED**

Mayor Bowyer asked Mr. Dean if he had obtained a firm price
quote on the computer and Mr. Dean explained what he had obtained
this would be a Pioneer Computer with a tape back up and an
14" SVGA Monitor and 1 Epson printer. Also the soft ware for
Microsoft Works for windows and 1 Peachtree complete 1 mouse
and 1 game port. also 2 cartons of computer paper. The price
quote was \$2237.71. Mr. Dean said he would pick up the equipment
and deliver it to us.

Mr. Neu motioned to purchase the computer seconded by Mr. Johnston for \$2237.71 with the general fund paying 1/3 (745.90) and the electric fund paying 1/3 (745.91) and the water fund paying 1/3 (745.91) Voting: Neu: YEA, Johnston: YEA, Craig: YEA, Dean: Abstain: Staggs: YEA. Voting: NAY. None. MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Bowyer asked Chief Canter if he had anything to report on the specs for a new police cruiser and Chief Canter said he did not have the specs.

Council went on record to try to purchase a new cruiser cost not to exceed \$9999.00 (Nine Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety Nine Dollars). Neu made this motion seconded by Mr. Johnston. Voting: Neu: YEA, Johnston: YEA, Craig: YEA, Dean: YEA, Staggs: YEA. Voting: NAY. None. MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Bowyer asked if there was any further business to come before the council; hearing none Johnston motioned and Dean seconded the motion to adjourn.

Mayor Bowyer adjourned the meeting reminding everyone of the next Council meeting to be held on Monday February 1, 1993 at 7:00 P.M.
