ORDINANCE NO. 1996-14

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A
MATERIAL HANDLING BUCKET TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown
County, Ohio, at least a three-fourths of its members concurring:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 735.051, there exists a real and present
emergency requiring the purchase of a material handling bucket truck for use by
the Village Electrical Department.

Section 2. That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to enter into a
contract for the purposes of purchasing a 1985 International material handling
bucket truck from Cincinnati Gas & Electric Company for the sum of \$11,000.00.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency
measure for the reason that it directly affects the health safety and welfare of the
residents of the Village of Hamersville.
