Mr. Stewart motioned to accept the minutes as presented.

Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Neu gave the second reading to Ordinance 1998-9 an ordinance on tractor trailer parking on the Village Streets

Loud Noise Ordinance was discussed and will be reviewed and suggestions made at the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Neu informed the Council that the Creek Crossing at Lake Grant was completed. Mr. Neu said he had complaints with clean up on Route 774.

There will be a sewer project progress meeting on July 16, 1998 at 2:00

P.M. Mr. Dean discussed how the old septic systems should be handled.

Mr. Dean motioned to purchase a fax machine for the mayors court building not to exceed three hundred (\$300.00). Ms. Craig seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED. Mayor Neu will pick out the new fax machine.

Ms. Craig motioned to join the state purchasing plan. Mr. Dean seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

The State put a stop sign at 774 and 125

The Carpet for Mayors Court was discussed. Mr. Neu is going to get the additional pricing done for the carpet. (A Copy of the cost estimate will become part of these minutes on the last page)

At the Mayors Court building as gutter is off. Mr. Green needs to check on this problem.

Mr. Dean motioned to have a new lock installed on the back door with keys that can not be duplicated. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED

Mr. Green needs to straighten up the park. There are trees that need to be removed and a guard needs to be placed around the water at the park

Mr. Dean motioned to purchase Four Tractor tires. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED

Mr. Dean motioned to approve the raises purposed by the BPA except the raise for the Clerk Treasurer. Ms. Craig seconded the motion. All voted YEA. MOTION CARRIED.

The Salary Increase for the Clerk Treasurer was tabled for ruling on interim pay increases.
