

A. ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF CLERK-TREASURER
FOR THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, BROWN COUNTY, OHIO

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of all members thereof concurring:

SECTION I. That the office of Village Clerk of Hamersville, Ohio, and the office of Village Treasurer of Hamersville, Ohio shall be combined into one (1) office and the person filling said office shall be known as Clerk-Treasurer.

SECTION II. That this combination shall be effective immediately upon the passage of this Ordinance for the reason that both the office of Clerk and the Office of Treasurer of Hamersville, Ohio, are vacant at this time.

SECTION III. That a certified copy of this Ordinance is hereby ordered served by the Clerk of this Village upon the Brown County Election Board and a receipt therefor obtained so that the Brown County Board of Elections may conduct a proper election for the office of Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, in 1979.

SECTION IV. That the salary to be paid to the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, effective immediately, shall be the sum of Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00) per year, payable monthly, with Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00) of said salary to be paid from the General Fund of the Village, and One Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$1,600.00) to be paid out of the electric and water funds of the Board of Public Affairs.

SECTION V. That nothing in this ordinance shall interfere with the previous merger of the Office of Village Clerk and the Office of Clerk of the Board of Public Affairs of Hamersville, Ohio.

SECTION VI. The term of the office of Clerk-Treasurer shall expire December 31, 1979.

for the reason that it has been very difficult to obtain persons to fill the Office of Village Treasurer and Village Clerk and that by a combination of these two offices, along with the previous combination of Clerk of the Village and Clerk of the Board of Public Affairs, a competent person may be obtained to fill said position, and this Ordinance shall be in immediate effect upon its passage.

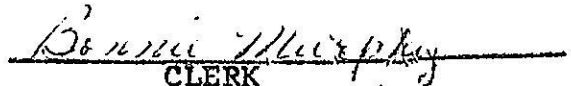
