Regular Village Council Meeting
March 13, 2006

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Keith Staggs, Larry Talbott, Harry Tolliver, Jack Shouse, Betty Kirkpatrick and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting, the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports, and the February 2006 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried. The Council read and approved all other reports and the Bank Reconciliation.
