

Village of Hamersville
Regular Council Meeting
DECEMBER 3, 1990

Present: Mayor Steve Bowyer, J.R. Elliott, Martha Hanes, Wyndal Staggs, Terry Stephens

Also Present: James Canter, Dennie Wooten, Joyce Craig, George Leicht, and Mr. Wilkin of Rumpke Waste Removal.

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order and asked if there was a motion to approve the minutes of the November 5th meeting as presented. Martha Hanes moved, J.R. Elliott seconded the motion to approve the minutes.

VOTING: YEA: Hanes, Elliott, Staggs, Stephens. NAY: None MOTION CARRIED

Mayor Bowyer asked Clerk Treasurer to open the two sealed bids for garbage removal. The bid from Rumpke was as follows: In 1991 \$5.00 per unit plus appropriate surcharges for 1991 by Federal, State and Local entities. The bid for '92 \$5.50 plus surcharges, and in '93 \$6.00 plus surcharges. However, since the surcharge for '92 & '93 may not be in full force at this time, Rumpke wishes to negotiate prices for 1992 & '93, sixty days prior to December 31st each year.

The second bid from Mound Company stated "Respectfully no bid at this time."

Discussion followed on the garbage bids. Basically we have received a one year proposal from Rumpke Waste Removal.

Hanes made a motion to table discussion of garbage bid until a later meeting. Stephens seconded the motion.

VOTING: YEA: Hanes, Stephens, Staggs, Elliott. NAY: None MOTION CARRIED

Discussion was held again on Roger Adkin's request for Village to vacate street. Solicitor Leicht will get back to Council on this matter at their next regular meeting.

Discussion on Park Project. The tables, grills, benches, etc. are to be cemented in by December 31, 1990. Mayor Bowyer will contact Commissioners to see if we can get an extension due to winter weather.

Martha Hanes informed Council the Community Christmas Party will be at 7:00 P.M. at the Fire House.

Snow removal was discussed. Mayor Bowyer said Township will not consider Village at top of their priority list for snow removal. Wyndal Staggs brought up subject of sidewalks not being cleared of snow by property owner. It is the property owner's responsibility to have sidewalk in front of their property cleared of snow. An article will be put in the News Democrat on this matter.

Solicitor Leicht will get Council name of an individual that perhaps would be interested in clearing snow from Village.

Streets.

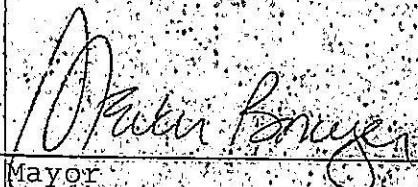
Council discussed a special meeting tentatively to be held December 19th at 7:00 P.M.
