Regular Village Council Meeting
July 12, 2004

Mr. Ogle made a motion to suspend the rules for reading a Resolution three times. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Ogle made a motion to adopt Resolution 2004-05, for election on tax levy. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes. The Clerk Treasurer presented the Bank Reconciliation for June, 2004, which the Council approved, the Warrant Register, Fund Status Report, Revenue Status Report and Expenditure Status Report.
