Regular Village Council Meeting
July 14, 2003

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Kevin Ogle, Betty Kirkpatrick, Harry Tolliver, Larry Talbott and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.
Also Present: Chief Jim Canter, Cecelia Potts, Eric Johnson, Gary & Carolyn Donner, Marsha Mundy and Tim Perry.

Mayor Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion. The motion carried, with all members voting yes.

Mayor Staggs recognized Eric Johnson, who may be interested in a Council seat.

Mayor Staggs recognized Ms. Donner, who asked about a street sign at Sisterville and Main Street. There hasn't been one there for a while. She also asked about the weeds at the old Longhauser residence. We already sent them a letter.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an Ordinance three times, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried with all members voting yes. Mr. Ogle made a motion to adopt Resloution 2003-08, changing the time limit for a second offense to 30 days from 6 weeks. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Staggs brought up the changes our magistrate wants to make in our junk car ordinance. Ms. Potts studied the changes, and informed Council that the changes would be fine for Mayor's Court, but if taken to County Court the ordinance could not be used because it does not follow State Statute. The Mayor will take it back to the Magistrate.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Ogle seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Chief Canter asked Cecelia about the blue house. She will find out how Mt. Orab takes care of their junk houses.

Ronnie Blair will fix the culvert on Wayne Avenue. Chris Baker agreed to allow us to ditch through his property. Mayor Staggs will have him look at the storm sewers on Main Street as well. Mayor Staggs will talk to the school about the water on the corner.

The Council agreed to take the flags down until Labor Day. Mayor Staggs will find out whose responsibility the holes in the parking lot at the Post Office are. Mr. Talbott thanked the Mayor for the job he has been doing. The Cloverbuds want to display flags they made in the hall. The Council thinks that is a wonderful idea.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to blacktop in front of the Police and Water building. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. We need to fix the crack in the roads we have paved in the last two years.

Mr. Talbott made a motion to call Chris Baker for any computer work, at \$15.00 per hour. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

The brick house on the corner of Bank and Walnut has about 6' of water

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in the basement. Jim or Wyndal will call the Health Department.

Chief Canter took the new cruiser to 32 Ford for service, and they did the recall work on the gas tank. Chief Canter commended his officers for their job on the citations for the junk cars. One of the people threatened an officer and tried to run. He was taken to jail. The Police Department caught a fugitive who has evaded them for a year and a half. Chief Canter asked Council for a stun gun. Mr. Ogle made a motion to have the Chief buy one, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to buy Kevlar vests and allow the officers to pay the Village back monthly. Mr. Ogle seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.
