Regular Village Council Meeting
June 8, 2015

Present: Mayor Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson, Jack Jones, Kathleen Miller and Fiscal Officer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Kirkpatrick called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

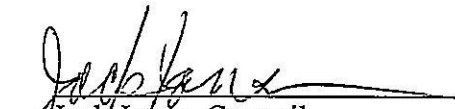
Ms. Miller informed Council that the Girl Scouts have some projects they would like to display here. We will look for some type of cabinet.

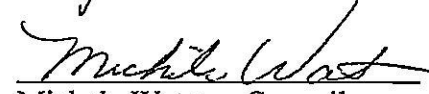
Mr. Jones made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Miller seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
