

Resolution 1989-12

METROPOLITAN HOUSING AUTHORITY

This resolution authorizes the Mayor to join with other government officials in Brown County in a petition to the Ohio Department of Development to form a metropolitan housing authority in Brown County.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is a shortage of affordable housing accommodations available to persons who lack the amount of income necessary to enable them to live in decent, safe and sanitary dwellings without congestion; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council of Hamersville recognizes the existence of a housing need within the boundaries of Hamersville, Ohio and overall in Brown County, Ohio and the need to address the problem at the local level; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Revised Code, provides through the Ohio Department of Development, procedures under applicable portions of O.R.C. Section 3735 for the establishment of a local Metropolitan Housing Authority.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE
VILLAGE COUNCIL OF HAMERSVILLE,
STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1. That the Village Council of Hamersville, Ohio desires to assist its low-income citizens in finding affordable housing which is decent, safe, and sanitary.

Section 2. That the Village Council of Hamersville, Ohio authorizes its Mayor to join with the Mayors of other Brown County

villages and/or other governmental officials in Brown County to submit a petition to the Ohio Department of Development requesting establishment of a Metropolitan Housing Authority for the jurisdictions desiring such including Hamersville.
