ORDINANCE # 2026-01

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REVISED USER RATES FOR THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO FOR; WATER RATES; VACATING THE PREVIOUS ORDINANCES AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, The Village of Hamersville supplies water to their Consumers;

WHEREAS, the supplier of the water to the Village has set new rates, and therefore the Village of Hamersville vacates the prior utility ordinances and;

WHEREAS, BE IT ORDAINED now therefore be it hereby ordained; the Council of the Village of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, at least 3/4 of its members concurring:

Section 1: Water Service Rate:

The in-town Residential Service Rate shall apply to single family residential consumers for all domestic uses and shall be charged per user per month. The operation, maintenance and replacement charges shall be made at the rate of \$27.75 per first 2,000 gallons for all usage, \$10.56 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

The in-town Commercial Service Rate shall apply to all consumers for purposes other than residential use and shall be charged per user per month. The operation and maintenance and replacement charges shall be made at the rate of \$29.00 per first 2,000 gallons for all usage, \$11.06 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

The out-of-town Residential Service Rate shall apply to single family residential consumers for all domestic uses and shall be charged per user per month. The operation, maintenance and replacement charges shall be made at the rate of \$30.00 per first 2,000 gallons for all usage, \$11.31 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

The out-of-town Commercial Service Rate shall apply to all consumers for purposes other than residential use and shall be charged per user per month. The operation and maintenance and replacement charges shall be made at the rate of \$31.00 per first 2,000 gallons for all usage, \$12.25 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

Section 2: Water Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall be effective for the March, 2026 reading of meters, to be billed in April, 2026.

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, require the immediate issuance of said ordinance and the same shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption.
