Regular Village Council Meeting
June 11, 2001

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle, and the following members of the Village Council: Donnie Sowers, Bill Dean, Brien Malicote, Wyndal Staggs and Kevin Ogle.
Also Present: Ron Schneider, Mr. & Mrs. Hanselman, Kenny Green, Brown County Commissioner Perry Ogden, Police Chief Jim Canter and Scott Lanter of the Brown County Press.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. He then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Neu recognized Mr. Ogden, who came to discuss tornado warning sirens that the Commissioners are placing in some of the Villages in the County. They have eleven planned, one of which is to be in Hamersville. The Commissioners will pay for installation. CG&E will donate the poles, and may set them as well. The Commissioners are applying for a CDBG Grant. The need us to write a letter of support for placing the sirens. These sirens are battery powered, and need 110 installation. They have a one year warranty, after that period of time we would pay \$100.00 for a maintenance contract for four years. These sirens will be activated by the 911 comm center in case of tornado. Mr. Dean made a motion to submit a letter to the Commissioners for the sirens. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mayor Neu then recognized Mr. Hanselman, who asked Chief Canter if there was a Police Report on a truck that ran off the road onto his property. Chief Canter told him that the incident had not been reported to the Police.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the financial reports to the Village Council, including a Warrant Register, Revenue Account Status, Expenditure Account Status, and Fund Status, as well as the minutes of the previous meeting. Mr. Sowers made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. Dean seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

The Council received a letter of resignation from Tim Sharp, President of the Board of Public Affairs. Mr. Staggs made a motion to accept the resignation, and Mr Dean seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Malicote seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mr. Dean made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an Ordinance three times. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Sowers made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2001-07, the 2001 Ohio Basic Code. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Ordinance 2001-08, regulating the storage of automobiles in the Village was read for the first time. Mr. Dean made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2001-08, and Mr. Staggs seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Ordinance 2001-09, regulating the accumulation of garbage in the Village was read for the first time. Mr. Sowers made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2001-09. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

The Council will hold Special Meetings on June 18th and June 25th at 7:00 for the second and third readings of these Ordinances.

Council told Chief Canter to start ticketing unlicensed vehicles on the street.

Brandstetter and Carroll want us to sign a contract with them to do the engineering for moving the sewer line at Neal's Corner. The contract will be for \$1,500.00. Mr. Dean made a motion to sign the contract, and Mr. Staggs seconded the motion. The motion carried, with all members voting yes, except for Mr. Ogle, who voted nay.

Mayor Neu informed the Council that Greenpeace has put our name in for a helper for Mr. Green. We are now on a waiting list.

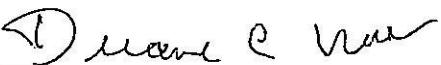
Mr. Dean wants Ronnie Blair to give us an estimate for widening Sisterville Road.

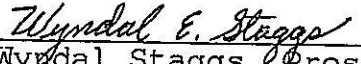
Chief Canter informed Council that they are now only holding court once a month. The Mayor will talk to Mr. Gusweiler about lowering his contract fees.

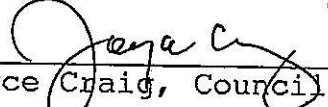

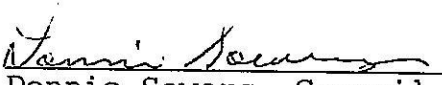
