Regular Village Council Meeting
July 8, 2002

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Wyndal Staggs, Diana Shuemake, Larry Talbott, Betty Kirkpatrick and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.
Also Present: Vernon Lotz, Stanley Dubiel, Dale Clark, Kevin Ogle, Hollee Chadwick, Scott Lanter, Kenny Green, Jesse Green, Police Chief Jim Canter, and Phil Patton.

Mayor Neu called this meeting to order, and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Neu then recognized Mr. Lotz, who came to bring to Council's attention a fire hydrant that is leaking at Fite Avenue. He also asked the Council to clean out the culvert under St. Rt. 125 at Fite Avenue. The Street Committee will go look at it. He told Council that when Adelphia was having their cable worked on, the tractor trailers drove in his driveway and through his yard. The Council told him to contact Adelphia. He also told Council that there are only 2 bolts holding the lid on his sewer grinder pump. Kenny will take care of this right away.

Mayor Neu recognized Dale Clark who came to discuss his sewer situation. The Street Committee will also go to his place to check on the water drainage problems there, as well as Adkins Place, the old park and Dan Lewis's property.

Mayor Neu then recognized Mr. Stanley Dubiel, who is running for County Auditor on the Democratic ticket. He informed the Council that he would be available for anyone who wants to talk with him, and asked for Council's support. He then thanked the Council for their time.

Ms. Potts then read Mr. Sowers' resignation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept it, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes. Mr. Staggs then made a motion to appoint Mr. Kevin Ogle to replace Mr. Sowers on Council, subject to his resignation from the BPA, and Mr. Talbott seconded the motion. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Shuemake made a motion to have Ronnie Blair take care of the ditches after the Street Committee looks at them. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

Mayor Neu presented a letter from Jamie Jamison, who wants to use the park for a rummage sale to raise money for her cheerleaders. It will be the first or second weekend in August. The Council was happy to agree to the sale.

Ms. Kirkpatrick has had some complaints about the dogs at Sullivan's on Main Street. They chased some children down the street last week. Ms. Potts showed the Police Department some State Ordinances that they can use.

The Clerk Treasurer informed the Council that in order to go on the UAN payroll system, we need to do away with the Payroll Clearing Account. Ms. Shuemake made a motion to do away with the account, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion. The motion carried, all members voting yes.

Chief Canter thanked the Clerk Treasurer for the clean-up letters. We had 34 of them. Some of the people are taking care of the problems. Tom Evans owns the old park on Wooster. We gave him a letter. This is at least partially our responsibility to clean up. A previous Clerk asked for and received permission from Mr. Evans to store some pipe on this property when we were building our sewer

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system. The Contractor stored sand and heavy equipment there as well. The contractor was also supposed to clean it up when they finished. They did not. The Street Committee will look into it. There were a lot of complaints about the condition of the streets when the Police Department gave out the clean-up letters.

Ms. Shuemade informed the Council that she received a lot of compliments on the flags. They looked good for the Holiday.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Shuemade seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.
