Regular Village Council Meeting
 December 13, 2010

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Wyndal Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Keith Staggs, Michele Watson, Betty Kirkpatrick, Ragan Ernst and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Donna Tolliver, Chief Canter, Skip Bollinger, Suzanne Madden, Abbey Elliott, John Wilson, Jason Ormes, Bob Neu, Brett Gaspard and Cecelia Potts.

Mayor Talbott called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Ms. Watson seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes. The Clerk Treasurer presented the Payment Register, Fund Status, Revenue Status and Appropriation Status reports to the Council, as well as the November, 2010 Bank Reconciliation. All reports and the Bank Reconciliation were read and approved.

Mayor Talbott recognized John Wilson, who owns Bantam Tire outside of Bethel. He wants to quote a price for snow removal on the Village streets. He told Council that he has been in business for 22 years. Mr. W Staggs told him that we have used the same contractor for several years, who answered our ads when no one else wanted our business. Ms. Ernst told Council that she had heard that our current contractor may not have a driver's license any longer. Mr. W Staggs and Ms. Watson told Ms. Ernst that his insurance covers his employees. Mr. W Staggs told Mr. Wilson that we will continue to use the current contractor this year, but Council would be happy to consider him next year.

Mayor Talbott recognized Bob Neu, who asked where the Village is on the drainage issue affecting his Church. Council wants to ditch away from town, but there is a property owner whose property we would have to go through. The Mayor and Street Committee will meet with Skip, Bob and Ronnie Blair to discuss the options.

Mayor Talbott recognized Brett Gaspard from Rumpke. He brought the new garbage rates:

- \$16.75 per customer for a 3 year agreement
- \$16.46 per customer for a 1 year agreement, with a raise the second year, or
- \$17.00 per customer for a 2 year agreement

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the 3 year agreement at \$16.75. Ms. Watson seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2010-12, concerning Yard Sales within the Village. Mr. K Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Increase 1000-720-162 Medicare	\$ 150.00

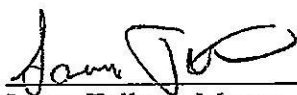
Mr. K Staggs seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Maoyr Talbott informed the Council that Roger Adkins still owns the property at the end of Adkins Place, and at this time he is not inclined to sell it.

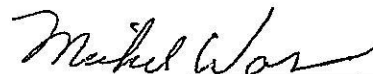
Chief Canter asked about the Police Department hours for December. Council told him to keep them at 60. Mayor Talbott told Chief Canter that the police Department means a lot to him.

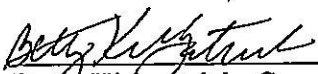
Mr. W Staggs made a motion to adjourn, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

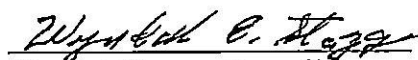

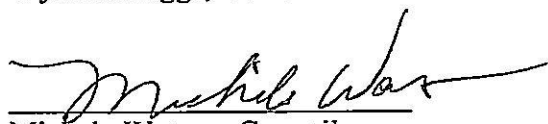
