Regular Village Council Meeting
May 14, 2007

Mayor Staggs called this regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Warrant Register, Revenue Status, Appropriation Status and Fund Status reports, and the April, 2007 Bank Reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, and Mr. Talbott seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.
