

RESOLUTION # 253

RESOLUTION DECLARING NECESSITY FOR A RENEWAL
TWO (2) MILL TAX LEVY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Incorporated Village
of Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio three-fourths or more of all
members elected thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION 1. That the amount of taxes that may be raised by
the levy of taxes at the minimum rate authorized
by Revised Code Section 5705.02 on taxable
property in said village will be insufficient
to abide an adequate amount for the necessary
requirements of said village, and that it is
necessary for the purpose of providing additional
funds for operational purposes that renewal taxes
be levied on the taxable property in said village
for a period of five (5) years at a rate in
excess of such maximum rate authorized by said
Revised Code 5705.02.

SECTION 2. That it is necessary to levy taxes for years 1970,
1971, 1972, 1973, and 1974 and that the rate for
each year of two (2) mills on each dollar of the
tax valuation of the taxable property within the
Village of Georgetown, Ohio in excess of the
rate authorized by said Revised Code Section
5705.02.

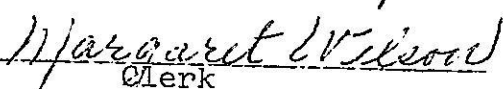
SECTION 3. That the Clerk be, and she hereby is, directed
to certify a copy of this Resolution to the
Deputy State Supervisors and Inspectors of
Elections of Brown County, Ohio and order that
said Supervisors and Inspectors of Election may
make the necessary arrangements for the submission
of such question to the electors of said village
as provided by law.

SECTION 4. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, directed to
cause notice of such election to be published as
required by law.
