REGULAR MEETING - COUNCIL
FEBRUARY 4, 1991 - 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Bowyer called the meeting to order. Mayor Bowyer said before approving the minutes as presented, he wanted to bring to Council's attention that the Brown County Sheriff's Department had sent a corrected contract making the daily rate for prisoners \$15.00.

Terry Stephens moved to approve the minutes of the January 7 meeting with the correction to Ordinance 1991-6 to be \$15.00. Pat Hanselman seconded the motion. VOTING; YEA: Stephens, Hanselman, Elliott, Moore, Staggs. NAY: NONE MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Bowyer asked visitors if they had any comments to bring before Council. The visitors were there to bring to Council's attention the bad condition of Dewey Avenue and the very bad drainage in that area. They would like Council to repair the street right away. A quite lengthy discussion was held. Council instructed Dannie Wooten to order a load of asphalt to use on their street to help alleviate the problem for a short period of time.

Mayor Bowyer said street committee would check into the drainage in their area and report back to Council at their next regular meeting.

The visitors thanked Council for their time and left the meeting.

The matter of roof repair was again brought up. Council will continue to see if they can get estimates for repairs.

Parking on Bank Street was discussed. Since this is the main street used by Fire and Life Squad vehicles, it's important that the street is not blocked by parked cars. Council instructed Dannie to install "NO PARKING" signs on Bank Street.

Wyndal Staggs brought up the subject of Roger Adkins' request for vacating Wayne Avenue and for Village to accept water lines. Discussion followed. Chuck Moore moved to invite Roger Adkins to the next regular Council Meeting. Wyndal Staggs seconded the motion. VOTING: YEA: Moore, Staggs, Elliott, Hanselman, Stephens. NAY: NONE MOTION CARRIED

Solicitor Leitch informed Council that a Public Hearing should be held on this matter. Mayor Bowyer read letter of resignation from Mr. Wooten. Council

tabled its acceptance until another meeting.

Mayor Bowyer appointed J. R. Elliot, Pat Hanselman and Wyndal Staggs to serve on a search committee. This committee will interview applicants for street commissioner. An ad has been placed in the News Democrat for this position.

Harper property discussed again. Solicitor Leicht will arrange to have Jeff Stine inspect the Harper property and try to have a report back at our March 4th meeting. Also, while Jeff is in area, Council would like for him to view the Dewey Avenue drainage area.

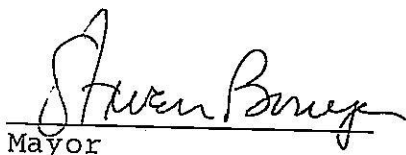
Chief Canter gave his report for January. Chief Canter said a communication system is badly needed by his department. His Officers are at times in a dangerous situation and have no way to call for back-up.

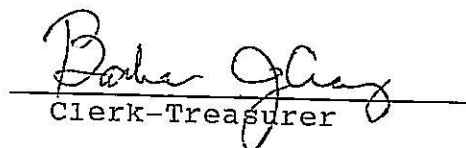
Council instructed Chief Canter to get figures for some type of a communication system.
