Mayor Bowyer called the special meeting to order and expressed his wishes for the village for 1993. Mayor Bowyer thanked council for their cooperation and efforts in helping the village.

Ms. Craig will finish the fliers for the public meeting for the sewers to be held on January 11, 1993 at 7:00 P.M. at the fire house. Dennie Schneider has been contacted and there is no problem with the village using the fire house.

A letter was read from Rumpke Waste Removal on batteries and old tires. Rumpke will no longer pick them up.

Mayor Bowyer presented the five year plan on issue 11 and said he will work hard for the village to try to obtain some funding for the various street and water department.

The Board of Public Affairs meeting which came to an abrupt halt was discussed and Mayor Bowyer appointed Mr. William Dean Sr. to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Mr. Jesse. Nester. Mayor Bowyer swore in Mr. Dean at this meeting.

More discussion was held on the parking on Main Street between 774 and North Ave. on the North Side and 774 and Bank Street on the South Side. The signs have been ordered to ban truck parking on this street.

The police committee has discussed the paid lunch time and will not recommend a paid lunch time for any one in the village at this time. Mr. Staggs wanted this in the minutes due to the fact that it had be discussed only and not approved.

Mayor Bowyer suggested that all departments get their "Wish Lists" Together so the new Budget can be prepared.

The Clerk Treasurer reported that she has been working on an error made to the IRS in 1989 and has not been able to find the mistake; the IRS says the village owes \$501.27 Mr. Hanselman motioned seconded by Mr. Dean to pay the IRS. the \$501.27. Voting: Hanselman: YEA, Dean: YEA, Craig: YEA, Neu: YEA, Staggs: YEA. Voting: Nay: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

A motion to pay the bills was made by Dean, seconded by Hanselman. Voting: Dean: YEA, Hanselman: YEA, Craig: YEA, Neu: YEA, Staggs: YEA. Voting: Nay: None. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Chief Canter reported that the Safety Vests for the Police Department cost \$22.00 (Twenty Two Dollars) each. Staggs motioned to purchase two vests seconded by Neu. Voting: Staggs: YEA, Neu: YEA, Craig: YEA, Dean: YEA, Hanselman: YEA. Voting Nay:

None. MOTION CARRIED.

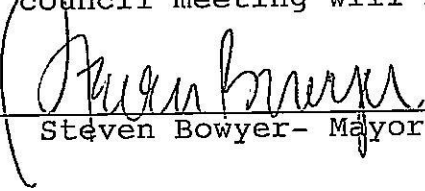
Chief Canter reported that he would have the year end report in January.

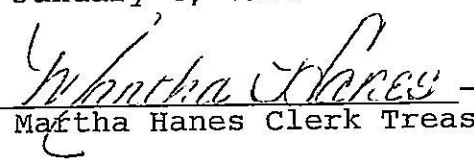
A discussion was held on the purchase of a new police cruiser and the village will need to do some more research on the specs. Chief Canter to get the specs together for the council so they can look at them.
