RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE EMERGENCY REPAIRS
TO THE WATER TANK OF THE VILLAGE OF
HAMERSVILLE AND OBVIATING FORMAL BIDDING
AND ADVERTISING FOR CONTRACT

WHEREAS, it appearing that the Village of Hamersville has been notified by regulatory agencies of the State of Ohio that the water pressure of the Village is below tolerable limits and that because of the low pressure the Village may be unable to provide satisfactory protection to the structures situated in the Village; and further appearing that in order to alleviate said low pressure and to make such other repairs to the tank as may be necessary for the protection of the tank and to insure sufficient pressure in the water system, it is necessary to make immediate repairs to the water tank, and

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of September, 1976, the Council of the Village of Hamersville adopted Ordinance # 1976-3, authorizing emergency repairs to the water tank of the Village of Hamersville and obviating formal bidding and advertising for contract and further declaring an emergency, and further appropriating the sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$5,500.00) from the water fund of the Hamersville Village to pay for these expenses.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Board of Public Affairs of the Village of Hamersville that the Board immediately proceed to secure the services of a contractor to make the necessary repairs to the water tank in accordance with Ordinance # 1976-3.
