Regular Village Council Meeting
March 8, 2004

Present: Mayor Wyndal Staggs, Kevin Ogle, Harry Tolliver, Larry Talbott, Eric Johnson, Betty Kirkpatrick and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Also Present: Cecelia Potts, Kenny Green, Police Chief Jim Canter and Wayne Boblitt.

Mr. Staggs called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting, as well as the Warrant Register, Fund Status, Revenue Report and Expenditure Report. Mr. Ogle made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. The Council read and approved the February 2004 Bank Reconciliation.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to appoint Tammie Ogle as Clerk Treasurer at the same salary. Mr. Johnson seconded the motion, and it carried, with all members voting yes, except Mr. Ogle, who abstained.

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The Council agreed to purchase a John Deere Lawn Mower for \$1,897.27. The clean-up days are May 13, 14 and 15 this year.

Mr. Talbott made a motion to close out the \$100,000 CD, and transfer the monies to our regular checking account. Mr. Tolliver seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

Mr. Staggs informed the Council that we were able to purchase the building at 130 West Main Street for our offices.

Mr. Tolliver is going to get "no parking" signs and replace the ones around town that are faded or missing.

Mr. Staggs recognized Chief Canter. He explained to the Council that there are houses on Main Street that have the same numbers, but are designated East or West. The Street Committee will check into getting numbers put on houses and a sign at Bank Street designating East and West. He also asked for deck blasters and a rear antenna for the blue cruiser. Council agreed to get them.

Mr. Tolliver made a motion to suspend the rules for reading an Ordinance three times. Mr. Talbott seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. Mr. Tolliver made a motion to adopt an Ordinance requiring houses in the Village to have numbers displayed. Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes. We will put a letter to this effect with the CCR's this year.

Mr. Staggs will contact the State about the hole coming out of McKinney Mart's driveway.

Mr. Ogle made a motion to adjourn, and Ms. Kirkpatrick seconded. The motion carried, all voting yes.
