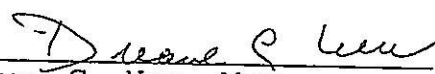
We will have a special meeting later this month for the sewer bonds.

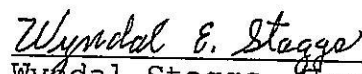

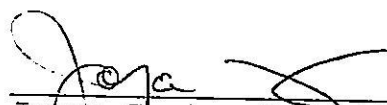
Mr. Fore made a motion to put Kenny Green back to work on Streets as well as sewers. Ms. Craig seconded the motion, and it carried, all members voting yes.

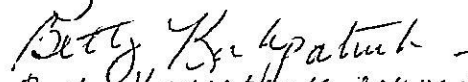
Ms. Craig made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all members voting yes.

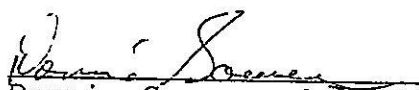

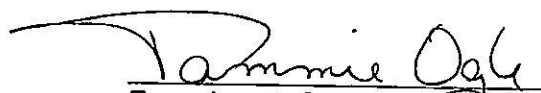
