Mr. Hill made a motion to pay all bills as presented. Ms. Miller seconded the motion, and it carried, all voting yes.

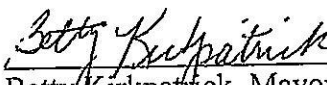
Shut off will be the 27th this month.
