

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-2

RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE APPROPRIATION
OF FEDERAL REVENUE FUNDS AWARDED TO THE
VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO

BE IT RESOLVED by the Counsel of the Village of
Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, three-fourths (3/4) or more of
the members thereto concurring as follows:

SECTION I. That as of January 1, 1984 and January
1st of each year thereafter the Village of Hamersville, Ohio
will appropriate Federal Revenue Sharing Funds as part of the
annual appropriation ordinance.

SECTION II. This Resolution is hereby declared to be
an emergency Resolution in that it is necessary for the public
safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of
Hamersville, Ohio, and more particularly for the reason that it
is absolutely necessary to have this Resolution passed before
January 1, 1984 so that the Federal Revenue Sharing Funds can
be appropriated properly and it is necessary to appropriate
the Federal Revenue Sharing Funds for the 1984 year by January
1, 1984, and this Resolution shall be in immediate effect upon
its passage.
