Regular Village Council Meeting
 August 9, 2010

Present: Mayor Larry Talbott, Keith Staggs, Harry Tolliver, Wyndal Staggs, Ragan Ernst, Betty Kirkpatrick, Michele Watson and Clerk Treasurer Tammie Ogle.

Mayor Talbott brought this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and then led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk Treasurer presented the minutes of the previous meeting to the Council, as well as the Fund Status, Revenue Status, and Appropriation Status reports, and the July 31, 2010 Bank reconciliation. Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to accept the minutes, and Mr. Talbott seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

Mayor Talbott told the Council that a Council member was of the opinion that in the last meeting he had talked down to Ms. Ernst. He apologized to Ms. Ernst.

Mayor Talbott recognized Janet Walters, who thanked them for tearing down the house next door to her.

Mayor Talbott recognized Bob Neu, who came representing Bible Chapel. They would like to install and extend a culvert at their cost. They are asking the Village to clean the silt out of all of the storm drains. Mr. Tolliver informed him that cleaning them out would be quite a challenge. Council agreed to look into it, and Ms. Kirkpatrick suggesting contacting Ronnie Blair about it.

Ms. Kirkpatrick made a motion to pay all bills as presented, and Mr. Tolliver seconded it. The motion carried, all voting yes.

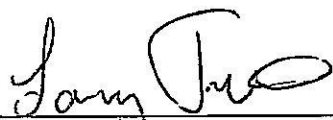
Cecelia has not heard from the Mortgage Company for the house on Bank Street. Council asked her to try to get NSP funds to pursue legal action for it.

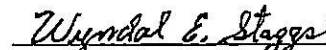

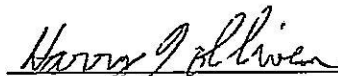

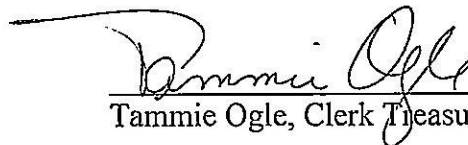
