

**VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE
ORDINANCE 2006-02**

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE ELECTRIC RATES CHARGED
TO THE VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE, OHIO, BILLING FUE DATES AND
DECLARING AS AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Village of Hamersville supplies electric to their
Consumers; and

WHEREAS, the supplier of the electric to the Village is setting new
rates, and

WHEREAS, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of
Hamersville, Brown County, Ohio, at least a majority of its members
concurring:

Section 1. Residential Service Rate:

The Residential Service Rate shall apply to single family residential
consumers for all domestic uses. Detached buildings, such as garages and/or
barns, if used solely for residential purposes, may be served from the
residential meter.

Next	40Kwh	\$0.197722 per Kwh
Next	140Kwh	\$0.150680 per Kwh
Over	220Kwh	\$0.103445 per Kwh

In addition to the above charges, there shall be an additional charge
known as the "fuel add on charge" which shall be based upon the fuel add on
charge billed to the Village by the Cincinnati Gas and Electric Company,
and shall be the same rate per kilowatt hour and charged to the Village of
Hamersville.

Section 2. Commercial Service Rate:

A Commercial Service Rate shall apply to all consumers for general
light and power service for purposes other than residential use. As used

herein, the term "for purposes other than residential use" shall be construed to include those situations where electrical power is consumed by the user in connection with the operation of a business such that electricity so consumed is directly used in the business operations as opposed to being merely incidental thereto. Detached buildings, garages and/or barns used in connection with the operation of a business may not be served through a residential meter.

Over	220Kwh	\$0.114880 per Kwh

Section 3. Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall be effective for the February, 2006 reading of meters, to be billed in March, 2006.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the reason that the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Hamersville, Ohio, require the immediate issuance of said ordinance and the same shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption.
