

VILLAGE OF HAMERSVILLE
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Regular Village Council Meeting
Monday December 14, 1998 7:00 P.M.

Present: Mayor Duane C. Neu, Clerk Treasurer Martha Hanes and the following members of the village council: William Dean Sr., Donald Sowers, Sue Sowers, Wyndal Staggs, Bryan Stewart.

Absent Joyce Craig.

Also present. James Canter, Eunice Ott, Cecelia Potts, Kenny Green, Jeff Merritt.

Mayor Neu called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Neu called for a motion to accept the minutes from the November 1998 meetings.

Mr. Dean motioned to accept the minutes as corrected. Mr. Staggs seconded the motion. All voted YEA. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Staggs complimented Kenny Green on his work on the village sewers.

The Christmas lights was discussed and the following will judge the lights on December 22, 1998 at 6:00 P.M. William Dean Sr, Bryan Stewart, Martha Hanes. The clerk will order plaques for the first three place winners.

Mayor Neu reported that he had contacted the Board of Health and they will order the serum for the hepatitis shots for Kenny Green and Colby Saylor. The cost will be one hundred dollars (\$100.00) each.

There was a discussion on filling the old septic tanks and sand, dirt or gravel is acceptable.

Ms Potts explained to the village council that the issue of Housers driveway needs to be resolved and that she will schedule a meeting with Houser, Grooms, Baker and the Mayor to see if this can be settled.

The Addendum to the garbage contract was presented and The addendum became RESOLUTION 1998-13.

Mr. Dean motioned to accept RESOLUTION 1998-13 and increase the garbage rates to eight dollars and forty cents (\$8.40) in the village and ten dollars and forty cents outside the village (\$10.40) Mr. Staggs seconded the motion. All voted YEA.

MOTION CARRIED.

The village streets need to be cleaned and Mr. Staggs motioned to have the streets swept before Christmas. Mr. Stewart seconded the motion. All Voted YEA.

MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. Dean reported that the village need to look for a hot tar kettle for the street department.

Mr. Green reported that the village dump truck is ready for the winter weather except for the salt spreader and Mr. Dean will weld the spreader this Thursday to have this done.

Chief Canter reported that everything has been quiet in the village.

Mayor Neu asked council to schedule a special meeting to go over the land use proposals. The Council agreed to have a special meeting on January 4, 199 at 7:00 P.M.

The village solicitors contract will remain the same for the next two (2) years.

Mr. Dean motioned and Mr. Sowers seconded the motion to renew the solicitors contract for two more years. Mr. Sowers seconded the motion. All voted YEA.

MOTION CARRIED.

Mayor Neu called for a motion to pay the bills as presented on the voucher.

Mr. Dean motioned and Mr. Staggs seconded the motion to pay the bills as presented. All voted YEA. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mr. Staggs motioned and Mr. Dean seconded the motion to allow the Mayor and the Village Clerk to pay any end of the year bills the village receives. Mr. Dean /seconded the motion. All voted YEA. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Mayor Neu asked if there was any further business to come before the meeting; hearing none Mr. Staggs motioned to adjourn. **MOTION CARRIED**

Mayor Neu adjourned the meeting.
