Regular Village Council Meeting
December 9, 2002

The Council unanimously agreed to continue to hold the retainage for Ameritcon until they are satisfied with the work.

Chief Canter informed the Council that the Police Department will be starting their fingerprinting at the school. The Village has had 2 chainsaws, a ratchet set and some other hand tools taken from the electric building. Chief Canter will file a report.

We need to look for a dump truck and snow blade for our Street Department. We also need to consider renting a chipper and taking it around to people's houses to get rid of the limbs.

Mr. Staggs made a motion to adjourn. Ms. Shuemaker seconded the motion, and the motion carried, all voting yes.
